



Teachers of the Yalanskaya school – veterans of the Great Patriotic war

I'm an eleventh-grader, you may say, I'm a senior. I'm finishing high school and looking back on my school years, I understand how boys need male teachers at school. So I'd like to tell about the teachers of our school, veterans of the Great Patriotic war. They are real heroes for boys. They are two, sorry, they were two: Grigory Prokopyevich Chimiris and Yakov Alekseyevich Kuritsyn.





Grigory Prokopyevich Chimiris

Grigory Prokopyevich was born on April 24, 1923 in Chelyabinsk region. The Chimiris family moved to the village of Yalanskoe in 1933. Here he continued his education at school. After graduating from the 7th grade, he entered the Safakulevskaya secondary school, the only one in the district at that time, in the 8th grade. It was in 1939. In may 1941, he finished the 9th grade, and on June 22, the war began, there was no question of further study, he had to go to defend Homeland.

In 1942, he became a cadet at the Tyumen infantry school. After school, he was sent to the Chelyabinsk 32nd reserve ski regiment.



Grigory Chimiris participated in the war as part of the Steppe front, participated in the battle of Kursk, liberated Ukraine, Romania, and ended the war in Czechoslovakia. After the war, he served as a member of the Central group of troops in Hungary, from where he was demobilized in 1946.

He had many government awards, and in commemoration of the 55th anniversary of the Victory in the great Patriotic war of 1941-1945, he was awarded the next military rank - major.





After demobilization, **Grigory Prokopyevich** returned to his native village, a former front-line soldier began working at a seven-year school as a teacher and studying at the Chelyabinsk pedagogical Institute. For the young teacher, this was the second front, because the difficulties of the post-war period had to be overcome not only in everyday life, but also at school.



In 1955 he was appointed Director of the school. In this position, he worked with some interruptions until 1979, for 17 years. Grigory Prokopyevich's school-the Chimiris school - was the name of the Yalanskaya school when it was run by this amazing gifted teacher.

He was a personal example to everyone, smart, decent and dedicated. He knew a lot about his students: home conditions, financial security, family relationships. He was a great master of listening to children and encouraging their activity.





Grigory Prokopievich was a frequent visitor to his native school after leaving for a well-deserved rest, and students and teachers often visited him.

Participants of the Great Patriotic war, who were united by the fact that they had a difficult childhood, started working early, chose the most peaceful profession on Earth – they became teachers, later-school leaders. On the eve of Victory Day in the Department of education as veterans of pedagogical work and participants of the Great Patriotic war.

Yakov Alekseyevich Kuritsyn

Yakov Alekseyevich is the same age as the Soviet Army, was born in a difficult 1918. And his birthday is November 7!

In 1935, after graduating from 7 classes of the Shchuchanskaya school, he entered the zootechnical school and after finishing the second year, in 1938, he went to serve in the Red Army. Yakov Alekseyevich didn't think, that service in the Army will be so long – for 19 years. No one knew that Hitler's Germany will attack our Homeland without declaring war.





In the harsh year 1941, a cadet of the Vladivostok military school Kuritsyn Ya. A. receives the rank of Lieutenant. And immediately - to the front. They entrusted a young officer with a machine-gun company of the Kalinin front. Lieutenant Kuritsyn's company repelled countless fascist attacks, retreating and advancing, losing combat friends.

In 1942 - a serious injury. They thought the young commander would not survive. He was in a crowded hospital in the city Basinki. The struggle with death lasted for a long time, but the young organism won.

In 1943, Yakov Alekseyevich was again on the front line, now on the Western front.

The young commander showed himself to be brave and resourceful in the battles for the Motherland, so a year later he is already a captain. The command of the unit in which Kuritsyn fought drew attention to the disciplined and courageous officer. And now he is already a student of the officers 'improvement courses.

1957 was a transitional year for Kuritsyn. He was discharged and arrived in his native Yalanskoe. He took off his shoulder straps and began peaceful life. The military-disciplined and efficient teacher of labor soon wins recognition here as well. For excellent work with the younger generation Yakov Alekseyevich was awarded Diploma of Ministry of education of the Russian Federation. And when the school introduced the program "Military Affairs", Yakov Alekseevich took up military - Patriotic education. In 1973, the Ministry of education of the RSFSR. appreciated the work of Ya. A. Kuritsyn, with sign "Excellence in public education".
